Tickets are \$20 each and available the day of the tour at Sumner Avenue and Stevens Street. Enjoy some of the finest homes in Spokane, see richly appointed interiors, and visit a secret garden. The tour includes four historic interiors at 319 W. Sumner; 404 W. Sumner; 503 W. Sumner, and 506 W. Sumner and the private garden at 526 W. Sumner. Visitors have this rare opportunity to view interiors and private gardens of landmark properties listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

The Moore-Turner Heritage Gardens is located west of the Corbin Art Center at 507 West Seventh Avenue. The Gardens are listed on the local, state and national historic registers and are situated in the Marycliff/Cliff Park National Register Historic District.
