Conservation Futures Public Meeting to Be Held at Riverfront Park's IMAX Theater October 12th



Spokane County Parks, Recreation, & Golf is now accepting public input for the 2010 Conservation Futures Nomination Round. This year, 36 individual properties have been submitted for consideration as future public open space areas providing opportunities for passive outdoor recreation such as hiking and bicycling.

We need *your* input to help prioritize future acquisitions! A public meeting to receive verbal input is scheduled to be held on Tuesday, October 12th at the IMAX Theater in Riverfront Park (Downtown Spokane) from 6-8 pm.
