On December 27, 2010, a 3-year contract between SpokAnimal and the City of Spokane Parks and Recreation Department was signed signaling the beginning of the first dog park within the City of Spokane. Thanks to a generous \$40,000 donation, Phase I of development is now underway with installation of fencing for the safety of our best friends and the security of the community. Fencing is scheduled to be completed by the end of January, at which time the Dog Park will open to the public.
