And even on a cloudy day it's spectacular!

High water in the Spokane River is now offering one of the best shows in town, and the Spokane Falls SkyRide is one of the most unique ways you can view the Falls.

With bright, sunny days forecast for the next week or so, now is the time to take in this spectacular display as the River thunders through the heart of Spokane.

About the SkyRide

Enjoy a 15 minute ride in an "all weather" enclosed cabin. Each of the 15 cabins is ADA compliant and can hold 6 passengers.

The SkyRide route takes you past art deco City Hall, then gradually dropping down 200 feet over the Huntington Park Natural Area. From there, you continue across the Spokane River, under the historic Monroe Street Bridge, and return to Riverfront Park.

Bring your camera and capture some memorable photos. The cabin windows open for clear shots.

PLEASE NOTE: Children 15 and under must be accompanied by an adult.
