Volunteers will be picking up trash and debris, and clearing the park of those last remaining pesky Hound's Tongue burr-bearing weeds. Please wear work gloves and slick burr-resistant clothing if you have it!

Also, there will be several loads of gravel that will need spreading, so bring along any tools that might be helpful in this enterprise - shovels, rakes, etc. Wheelbarrows are also needed.

SpokAnimal will provide bottled water and snacks.

Here are the details:

What: Dog park work party to pick up trash and spread gravel

Who: Everyone who can help. Please bring work gloves, shovels and rakes. Wheel barrows are also needed. Garbage bags provided. Well-behaved dogs welcome!

When: SATURDAY, February 19, 2011, beginning at 10:00 am

Site: Approximately 11-acres bordered by Riverside, Government Way and "A"

Directions: Take Riverside west from downtown. Look for "A" Street and turn left. If you are coming on Government Way, turn east on Riverside; look for "A" street and turn right.
