THREE DAY PERMIT ISSUED

The Parks and Recreation Department has issued a three-day transient shelter permit to the group, Occupy Spokane, allowing the group's extension into Franklin Park, located at the northwest corner of Division Street and Queen Ave. During those three days City staff will work with representatives of Occupy Spokane to attempt to come to a longer term agreement that is open and flexible but also takes into account the integrity and intent of rules that pertain to all Spokane city parks and their use by all citizens. A second three-day permit is allowed and can be granted.
