#### When do the (6) City of Spokane Aquatic Centers open for 2011?

City of Spokane Aquatic Centers are scheduled to open at 12:00P on June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2011. Witter Aquatics Center will open for pre-season lap swim on May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2011 and lap swim during this time will run from 11:30A – 1:00P. #### How much does it cost to swim?

*ALL GUESTS ARE REQUIRED TO PAY ADMISSION, REGARDLESS OF USE.*

- **Daily Admission:** **Youth** 4-17 pay \$2.  
**Adults** 18 and over pay \$4.  
**Children** 3 and under are free.  
**Seniors** 65+ \$2  
**Lap Swim:** \$2
- **Season Passes:** **Youth** 4-17 \$60  
**Adults** 18+ \$120  
**Seniors** 65+ \$60 – These passes are good June 20<sup>th</sup> – August 28<sup>th</sup> 2011 at ALL city Aquatic Centers during open swim times.

#### What programs are available to youth who may not have the funding necessary to take advantage of the City Aquatic Centers?

The Spokane Parks Foundation provides access to free swimsuits and swim lessons to those who meet certain economic qualifiers. Sponsored swim passes are also available. Please contact 509.625.6200 for more information.

#### Does the Spokane Parks & Recreation Department offer swim lessons?

**YES!** The Aquatics program employs American Red Cross certified instructors to teach the nationally recognized *Learn-to-Swim* curriculum. Levels are available for ages 6mos to 18yrs.
